Fees/Refunds:

All camp fees (weekly & daily) are due the first day (Monday) of the camp. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to this. Campers will not be allowed to attend any field trips unless field trip, camp, and membership fees are current. Field trips may have limited spaces. **Membership and camp fees are non-refundable.** Field trip refunds require 72 hour notice prior to the trip and will be subject to a \$10.00 administrative fee per camper.

We accept Visa and MasterCard, checks or cash payment. Checks may be made payable to "Boys & Girls Club". There will be a \$25.00 fee for any returned check. After one (1) returned check during the summer camp sessions, all further payment must be made by cash or money order. The Boys & Girls Club will pursue collection action for all returned checks. **The Boys & Girls Club does not provide an account total at the end of the year. It is the parents' responsibility to pick-up their weekly receipts, which are the only record of payment. These receipts may be picked-up at the front desk.**

What to Bring to Camp:

Each day campers need to bring a non-perishable sack lunch, as well as snacks for the day. Please do not rely on our snack bar for lunches as we cannot guarantee a large variety of items. For all beach, pool and water days, campers must bring a swimsuit, towel, and sunscreen. We recommend that campers bring their lunch and belongings in a backpack and that all items be marked with the child's first and last name.

Sunscreen:

It is the parent's responsibility to provide and apply sunscreen to each camper prior to camp drop off. Camp staff will remind the campers to re-apply during the day, however will not physically apply the sunscreen to your child. We recommend the spray type of sunscreen so that we can better assist your child with application.

Late Pick-Ups:

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to pick their camper up on time (6:00pm). If a camper is picked up late on a consistent basis their membership in the program may be revoked.

What to Leave at Home:

Please leave all electronic devices and toys at home. The Boys & Girls Club of the Harbor Area is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
